- Change request form
 - Robust business case necessary
 - Clarity and benefits of change crucial
- Deadline for requests – 24 June 2011
- Reviewed against criteria
- Review group – 7 July 2011
 - Government departments and agencies
 - Sector groups

Process and timetable (2)

- Consultation meeting with advisory group representatives
 - 21 July 2011
 - Limited numbers
- Consultation – July/August
 - Surveys
 - **Feconnect**
 - Usual publications
 - Comments also to cst@theia.org.uk
- Board meeting – 28 September 2011
- Specification published – 25 November 2011.

- Business case against criteria
 - Failure on any one likely to lead to rejection
 - Additional information
 - Write to the Head of *the information authority*
